## INTRODUCTION

This document contains the data codebook for the 2005 Leisure Needs Survey undertaken by the Community and Family Support Center of the Department of the Army. It contains a list of all the questions asked on the survey, the multiple choice answers associated with each question, and the manner in which each response was coded numerically. It also contains descriptions of variables that were created after the data collection ended in order to facilitate analysis and reporting.

**Please note:** Missing values are coded as a blank (“ ”) or a “-1” or a “6”, depending on the question. In the pages that follow, answer choices treated as missing are so marked next to that response option.
